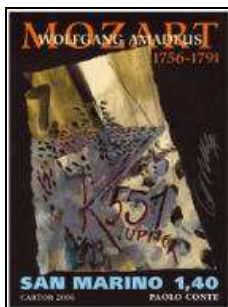
11.11.2006 (Chuichi Maeda / Japan)
